

MACMILLAN PROFESSIONALS EXCELLENCE AWARDS

INTEGRATION CRITERIA AND QUESTIONS

This category recognises nominees and teams who have improved the coordination of services and enabled integration across settings such as acute, primary, social and voluntary or through digital services to provide a seamless experience for people living with cancer.

Judges will look for collaboration with a range of stakeholder groups including people living with cancer and measurable impact at local, regional or national level.

Question 1 the maximum number of characters with spacing is 1900 (equates to 300 words). Please note: this question will not be scored. Questions 2 – 6 the maximum number of characters with spacing is 1600 (equates to 250 words).

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| <p>1. Please provide an overview of the Integration initiative, outline the problems or issue that this initiative was seeking to address, and how this was identified. Please make sure you address the specific criteria for this award.</p> |
| <p>2. Please explain how the nominee or team have demonstrated leadership and team working and that they are a role model for others. This should demonstrate how they have exceeded the requirements of their role or remit.</p> |
| <p>3. Provide evidence of how the nominee or team have influenced / engaged / collaborated with key stakeholders and worked across boundaries to ensure success. Include detail of any challenges and how these were managed.</p> |
